The JA Job Shadow program provides students with the opportunity to visit local businesses where they can observe a professional work environment, learn about the careers that are available, and talk to employees about their jobs and experiences. Students also learn what skills are needed for a career in a particular industry and the importance of educational attainment in achieving their goals. In addition to visiting a local business, the JA Job Shadow program includes three additional classroom sessions (two before the field trip and one after) that reinforce important concepts such as career research and preparation, job-hunting skills, and professionalism and ethics in the workplace.
