

PLEASE NOTE: All events that require sign-ups or RSVP are due 1 week prior to event date.

College/Career Presentations for students: The OC Guidance Department will be doing college and career presentations during this week for the senior class.

College Advisement Drop In: Guidance counselors will be available to answer any questions regarding the college process. Parents are welcome to drop in at any point during this time.

Financial Aid Seminar: This seminar, sponsored by the Massachusetts Educational Finance Authority (MEFA), will provide information and clarity on the entire college financial aid application process. You'll learn about financial aid applications and types of financial aid, the factors that determine your aid eligibility, how colleges determine the amount of aid to offer, and the details of financial aid award letters. All parents and students are welcome to attend. Please RSVP by calling 508-763-8011 ext 231.

Application Day: Students will have the opportunity to work on or complete any college application with the OC guidance department. Students are strongly recommended to begin the application prior to this day. Students should sign up in the guidance office in advance.

FAFSA Night: Advisors from the Educational Opportunity Center (EOC) will be visiting Old Colony. Unlike the previous financial aid presentation, during this time representatives from EOC will be helping you by appointment only to complete the FAFSA form and submit it online that evening. There will be no appointments scheduled that evening to complete the CSS Profile The CSS Profile is a different online application that collects information used by nearly 400 colleges and scholarship programs to award non-federal aid. (For federal aid you must complete the FAFSA form). There is a list from the EOC (on the Old Colony website) stating the necessary documentation to bring on November 6th. Please review this list to be sure that you have everything that is essential for completing the process. Having an extra copy of your taxes available will be helpful. ACCUPLACER Testing: This placement test is needed for BCC and other local community colleges. All students planning to enroll in a degree or certificate program are required to take college placement tests in order to ensure appropriate placement in classes. The results of the assessment, in conjunction with academic background information, are used by college academic advisors to assist you with course selection.

BCC On-Site Admissions: Bristol Community College will hold on-site admissions at Old Colony. Students must complete the paper application (located in guidance) and sign up in the guidance office.

UMass Dartmouth On-Site Admissions: UMass Dartmouth will hold on-site admissions at Old Colony. Students must complete their UMD online application or Common Application one week prior. Students must sign up in the guidance office.

Other important information: Please be aware of your college application deadlines. Many programs (such as nursing and engineering) have earlier deadlines. Student and families should check your intended school to see if they require the SAT test. Dates for the test are available on Collegeboard.org. Guidance counselors are available to help with any questions.

PSAT INFO

There is still time to sign up for the PSAT's!

The PSAT/NMSQT qualifying test, which is required for some college acceptances, and qualifies students to be eligible for college scholarships, has been scheduled at Old Colony RVTHS on Saturday, October 19, 2019. All sophomore and junior students are eligible to take this test. The cost of the test is \$27.00. Both cash and checks are accepted. Checks can be made out to Old Colony Vocational Technical High School. Fee waivers are available to juniors (Class of 2021) who receive free/reduced lunch.

Students who are interested in taking will need to register in the OC Guidance Office. Registration deadline is October 11th, 2019.

Students are responsible for their own transportation and must arrive at Old Colony RVTHS between 8:30 and 8:45 a.m.

Students will be dismissed from testing at approximately 1:00 p.m. Students arriving after 8:45 a.m. will not be allowed to take the test and test fees will not be refunded.

Students can go online at collegeboard.org/psatpractice for a practice test or to find out more about the test (see the PSAT student guide for more info).

PSAT/NMSQT and SAT's are NOT required for students who are interested in pursuing a degree at Bristol Community College or any other community college. Please also note that not all four-year colleges require SAT

scores. Students should review each college's specific requirements. For more information call the Guidance Department at 508-763-8011 x127, x128 or x129.

SAT TESTING INFORMATION

There are now more than 1,000 accredited, bachelor-degree granting institutions that have changed their approaches to standardized test scores. Keep in mind that the majority of colleges, especially the more prestigious schools *do* still require (and strongly consider) SAT scores. Since admissions processes are complex and unique to each school, students and parents should **explore the policies of all the colleges of interest** by looking on the college's website, or calling an admissions officer and ask directly if SAT testing is required.

Students who receive free/reduced lunch are eligible to take the SAT for free and should see their guidance counselor before registering for the test to get a SAT Fee Waiver.
