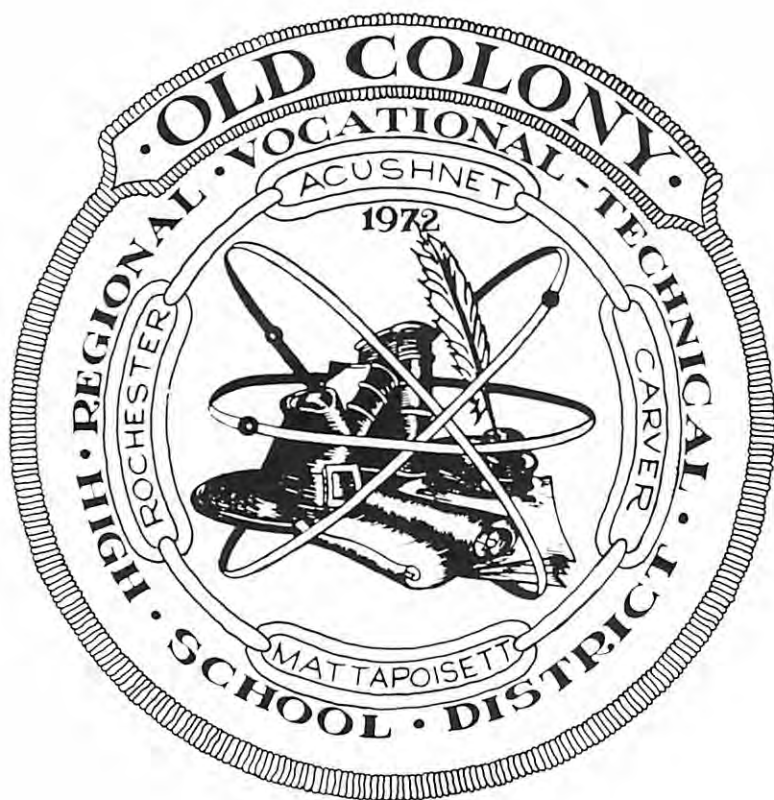

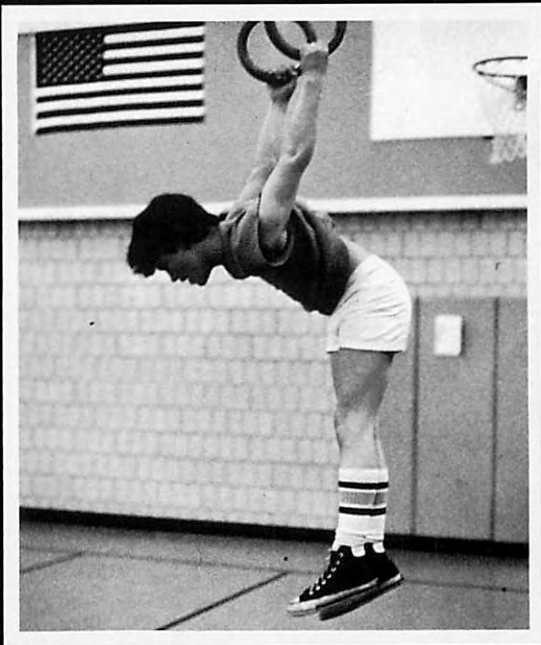
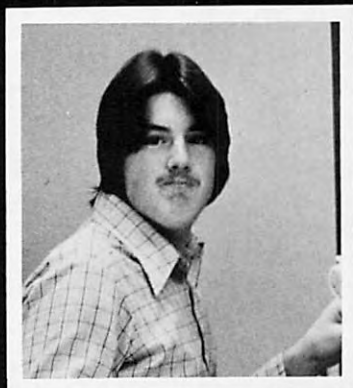
Like the pine trees lining the winding road.

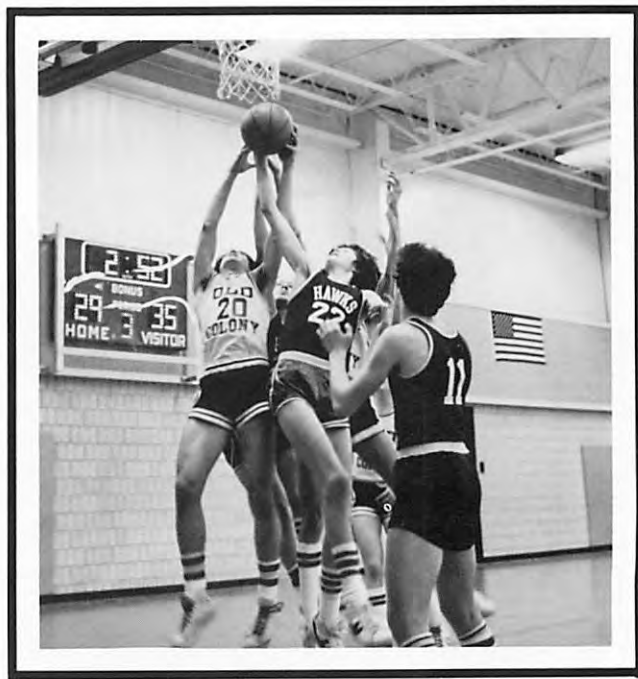
Jim Jason was the first player from Old Colony to be picked for the Mayflower League All Star Team.

The determination and dedication of the team was good. The talent obvious. The teamwork helped make the season a success.

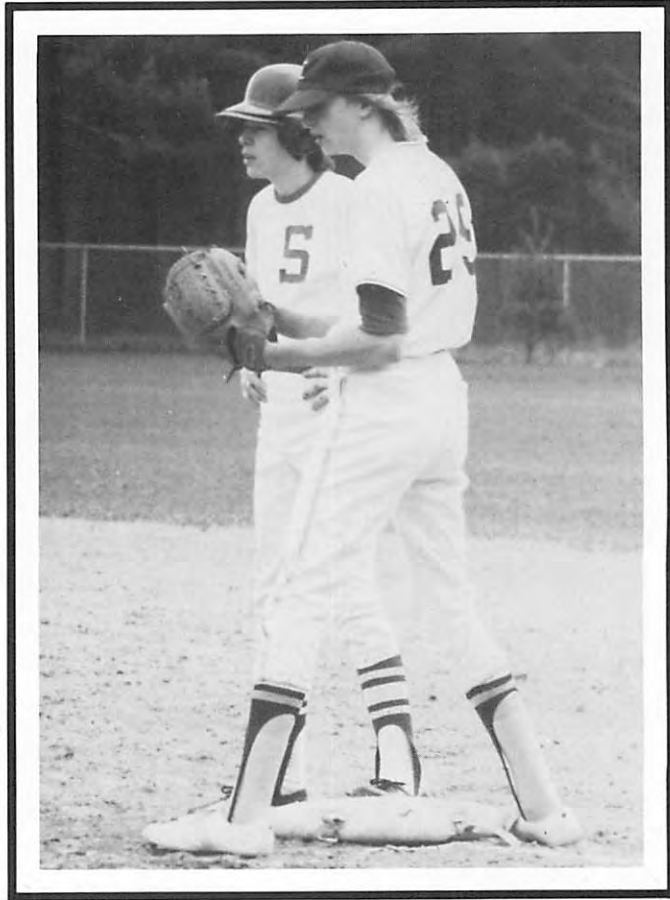

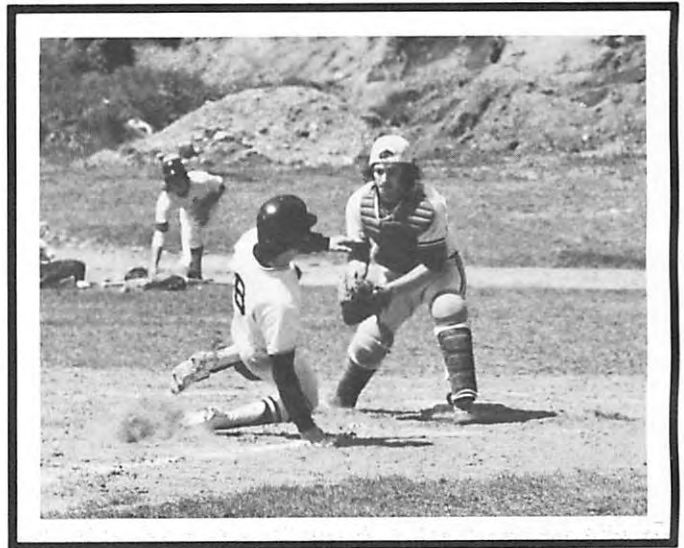
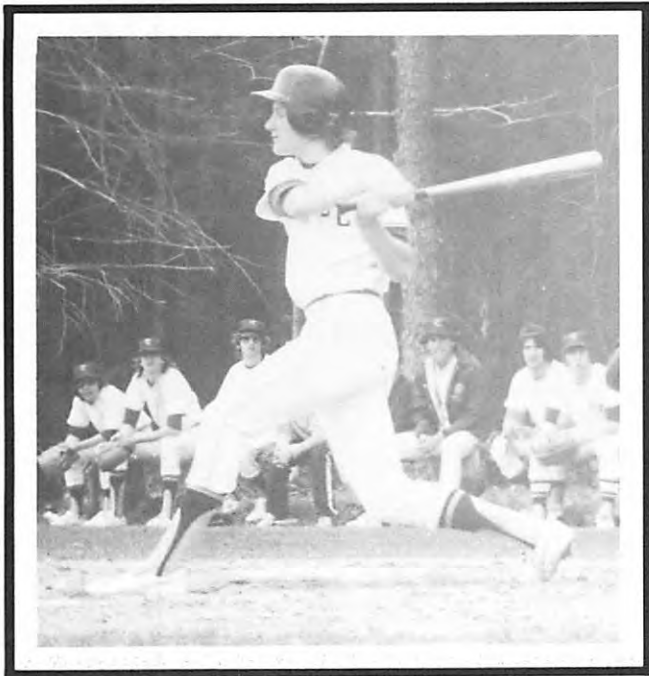
After facing the league's tough competitors like Apponequet, Avon, Norton, and Cape Cod Tech, the Cougars finished the season with a 2-16 record.
